Dear Friends,

Happy Spring! It's been a long winter and thankfully spring is around the corner. Thank you for being patient with us as we survived the winter months together. Making the decision to close the doors at the Senior Center is never an easy decision. Please know that when we make the choice to close, it's not to punish but rather to protect our staff and center members.

We have so much to share with you in this edition of our quarterly newsletter. The first event, and most exciting, is our celebration on June 6, ***Two Decades of Gratitude***. Believe it or not, we have been in our building for 20 years. Many of you remember the hard work and dedication from our board members, community volunteers, and staff who brought this project to fruition. We have staff who worked at the 3rd Street location and remember moving into the new building. The investment from our donors has proven to impact our seniors greatly with the programs, services, and facilities that we are blessed to have. Please mark your calendar for **Friday June 6**. It will be a fun day filled with great food, live music, prizes, raffle baskets, and more. We will conclude the celebration with a Patio Party featuring Randy Velez as our main entertainment. We will also have food trucks available to our guests to purchase from. The Howlin Bird and The Black Sheep Salad truck will be available from 4:00pm-7:00pm.

If you haven't heard, we welcomed our newest satellite center, Tusky Valley Senior Center to our family. They are located within the old Tusky Valley High School and are open Tuesday-Friday, 8:30am-1:30pm. The new manager is Nancy Raber and she has been overwhelmed with the support and participation from the community.

If you haven't been to the Dover Center lately, please come by to enjoy our new look. We have put a fresh coat of paint on the walls, door jams and windows. We have updated our furniture in the lobby and increased our seating capacity. We have updated the wall décor throughout and added a smart board to our social room for community use as well as lunch and learn presentations. Of course, the new floor was laid in December and it looks beautiful with the new furnishings. We could not have done all of this without our friends at the Reeves Foundation, Kimble Foundation and ARPA funds from Area Agency on Aging, Region 9. Our new look did not cost our tax payers a penny in that no levy dollars were used.

I want to congratulate two of our directors who will graduate from Leadership Tusc in May. Elaine Booth, Director of Activities and Marley Miller LSW, Director of Social Services have participated in the 9 month program learning about Tuscarawas County resources, community engagement, and leadership styles. They both have worked very hard to successfully complete this program and they deserve our recognition of a job well done. CONGRATULATIONS TO ELAINE AND MARLEY!

Finally, this is a levy year for the Tuscarawas County Senior Center. The Board of Directors have approved a .8 mil replacement levy to be placed on the November 2025 ballot. Our next step is to submit a request to the Tuscarawas County Commissioners to approve our levy ballot request. Our current levy of .8 mil has been in existence since 2015. Through the years, our recovery of funds has dropped from 100% of .8 mil down to less than 75% in some areas like commercial, residential, and public utility. Our only goal is to get back to the 100% of the .8 mil levy to recover all the funds that the taxpayers believe we are entitled to.

The Tuscarawas County Senior Center newsletters are available in larger print for individuals with sight impairments. For those with limited English an interpreter can be made available.

What does a replacement levy mean to you as a tax payer? GREAT QUESTION! For those of you in a \$200,000 home, it would be \$56 per year. For those in \$400,000 home, it would be \$112 per year. We have been an excellent steward of the levy funds entrusted to the organization through the years. We will continue utilizing levy funds for programs and services that meet the needs of our seniors, age 50 and older, in Tuscarawas County. The board of directors and I will be traveling the county to present our success stories, data on usage of programs and services by seniors, and our need to build capacity to continue serving the largest number of seniors ever, the Baby Boomers. Stay tuned for more information as we move through 2025.
